POSITION: Assistant Professor - Industrial Design EEO # AR 1-09

RESPONSIBILITIES: The School of Architecture and Design seeks a professor with commitment to undergraduate education and expertise in Industrial Design for a growing B.I.D. Program with 61 majors. Candidate should have excellent pedagogy in industrial design and a strong background in design through education and professional practice. The candidate will need to have expertise in design studio; materials and processes including 3D modeling (AutoCAD and Rhino) and rapid prototyping technologies are essential (such as Dimension 3D printer). The successful candidate will be expected to engage in creative research, scholarship and service to the program, school and University. A large emphasis will be placed on the candidate's willingness to work with colleagues on issues related to the program development. Peer reviewed recognition of teaching and/or professional design works desirable.

QUALIFICATIONS: Master's Degree or Ph.D. in appropriate discipline required and IDSA affiliation desired.

ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT: The College of the Arts includes the School of Architecture and Design, School of Music, Department of Performing Arts and Department of Visual Arts. The School of Architecture and Design has a full-time faculty of 20 and serves 528 majors in architecture, industrial design, interior design, and fashion design. The Industrial Design Program has three full-time faculty who in conjunction with other faculty in the School serve 61 majors in the B.I.D. degree program.
