- POSITION:** Instructor, Integrated Technology, Department of Educational Curriculum and Instruction
This position is a nine-month appointment in the College of Education, plus requires working in June with additional summer pay.
- RESPONSIBILITIES:** The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching undergraduate courses in Educational Technology and serve as the liaison for the College of Education portfolio system, Pass-Port. In addition, duties include advising students in the College of Education; supervising student teachers; serving on departmental, college and/or university committees; and engaging in scholarly activities. The successful applicant will be expected to participate fully in other activities of the department, college, and university.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** The applicant must have an earned Masters degree in Educational technology or in education with a certification or specialization in technology. Candidates must have at least three years of experience in K-12 schools. Experience teaching at the college level is desirable. Preference will be given to applicants who have experience with educational technology.
- ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT:** The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is one of eight publicly supported universities governed by the University of Louisiana System. Our university consists of nine degree-granting colleges and the Graduate School. The university's enrollment is approximately 16,300 and it employs 550 full time faculty. UL Lafayette offers 60 undergraduate degrees, 27 master's degrees and 8 doctoral degrees. The College of Education consists of three academic departments in the disciplines of Educational Curriculum and Instruction, Educational Foundations and Leadership and Kinesiology.
