- Position:** *Instructor*, Department of Sociology, Anthropology and Child & Family Studies, beginning August 2012. This is a non-tenure track, renewable, appointment in Sociology.
- Responsibilities:** Primary teaching responsibilities include undergraduate General Sociology and Contemporary Social Problems. Candidate will be required to serve as an academic advisor to sociology majors and assist in other duties as assigned.
- Qualifications:** Earned Ph.D. in Sociology preferred, other Sociology related specialties considered; ABD considered. A minimum of an M.A. or M.S. in Sociology required. Preference will be given to applicants who demonstrate a strong commitment to teaching and service. Teaching experience desirable.
- The University:** The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is a selective-admission, state-supported university of approximately 16,300 undergraduate and graduate students, located in the heart of Louisiana's Acadian-Creole region between Houston and New Orleans. The University offers undergraduate degrees in 75 disciplines, the master's degree in 26 disciplines; and the doctorate in 9 disciplines.
- The Department:** The Department is located within the College of Liberal Arts comprised of 9 departments in the humanities and behavior sciences. It is composed of 12 Sociology faculty, three Anthropology faculty, and four Child and Family Studies faculty. The faculty offer curricula leading to a B.A. or B.S. in the respective fields.
